Minimum Registration Standards

A very big Thank You to everyone who responded to my audit of Venue Registration Minimum Standards, I am really keen to hear from the Clubs who have not as yet responded. It's great to see that so many of you now have a trained Welfare Officer at your venue, or you are in the process of having one.

From **1 October 2018**, all venues will be required to meet five **Minimum Registration Standards**.
