### **Tennis Competition A: Year 3&4 Mini Tennis Red Festivals**

#### **LONDON BOROUGHS OF BROMLEY/ BEXLEY / LEWISHAM & GREENWICH**

##### **Local events leading to finals**

<b>Organiser</b>	School Games Organiser (SGO) for each borough/area. The winning School qualifies for the London Youth Games.
<b>Player Standard</b>	Year 3 or Year 4 Players with an Orange 2/ 1/1* or Green rating or above are <b>ineligible</b> to play
<b>Player Format</b>	4 players per team ( <b>MUST</b> include 2 girls for London)
<b>Events</b>	Mini Tennis Red (badminton size court, soft balls, 21"/23" rackets)
<b>Organisation</b>	Varies depending on SGO/area (often doubles matches scored by leaders)
<b>Scoring</b>	Timed matches with tie-break scoring (1-0, 1-1, 2-1 etc.)
<b>How to Enter</b>	Speak to your SGO or club/coaching team
<b>Where/When</b>	From April onwards in your borough
<b>Cost</b>	FREE

#### **KENT BOROUGHS**

##### **Local events only**

<b>Organiser</b>	School Games Organiser (SGO) for each borough/area. This event is a Level 2 development competition only.
<b>Player Standard</b>	Year 3 or Year 4 This event is for beginner players only.
<b>Player Format</b>	Varies depending on SGO/area
<b>Events</b>	Mini Tennis Red (badminton size court, soft balls, 21"/23" rackets)
<b>Organisation</b>	Varies depending on SGO/area
<b>Scoring</b>	Varies depending on SGO/area
<b>How to Enter</b>	Speak to your SGO or club/coaching team
<b>Where/When</b>	From April onwards in your borough
<b>Cost</b>	FREE





## **Tennis Competition B: Kent Team Competition**

### **One day events**

**Each School entering must have a responsible adult in overall charge of players which is in attendance.**

<b>Organiser</b>	Kent Tennis and Venue Competition Organiser
<b>Player Standard</b>	Generally for more advanced players with a rating and playing experience
<b>Player Format</b>	4 players in a team, separate events for girl's teams and boys teams
<b>Events</b>	Mini Tennis Red (Year 3 and below) Mini Tennis Orange (Year 5 and below) Mini Tennis Green (Year 6 and below) *players can only play in 1 event
<b>Organisation</b>	Each team will play against other teams with 4 singles and 2 doubles in each team match. Starting in round robin boxes, leading to further matches until the 2018 Champions have been found. *Each team must have a manager who is on the courtside with the players and is able to score
<b>Scoring</b>	Timed matches with tie-break scoring (1-0, 1-1, 2-1 etc.)
<b>How to Enter</b>	Use attached entry form or download from Kent Tennis website
<b>Where/When</b>	In the Bromley area in May (see entry form for more detail)
<b>Cost</b>	See page 2 of the entry form

## **Tennis Competition C: Kent Schools Annual Doubles Championships**

### **Local qualifier events leading to county finals**

<b>Organiser</b>	Kent Tennis and Teachers/Coaches from Schools entered
<b>Player Standard</b>	Open to everyone – less experienced through to advanced
<b>Player Format</b>	2 players in a team, separate events for girl's teams and boys teams
<b>Events</b>	Mini Tennis Red (Year 3 and below) Mini Tennis Orange (Year 5 and below) Mini Tennis Green (Year 6 and below) Yellow ball Tennis (Year 6 and below) 1 day event on 21 <sup>st</sup> June *players can only play in 1 event
<b>Organisation</b>	Doubles matches starting in round robin boxes which may lead to further matches – top teams qualify for county finals. *All participating schools are expected to provide a teacher/coach/who is able to help with the running of the event.
<b>Scoring</b>	Timed matches with tie-break scoring (1-0, 1-1, 2-1, etc.)
<b>How to Enter</b>	Use attached entry form or download from Kent Tennis website
<b>Where/When</b>	Qualifying events – Bromley (12 <sup>th</sup> June 2019) Canterbury (13 <sup>th</sup> June 2019) Finals – Bromley Tennis Centre – Friday 21 <sup>st</sup> June 2019 ( <b>invitation only</b> ) <b>See entry form for more detail</b>
