KENT TENNIS STATEMENT

4 November 2020

It is with regret that we advise you, following the latest guidelines agreed today by Parliament, that the LTA have confirmed all tennis activity in England is not permitted for the duration of the national lockdown, as a result of the closure of all outdoor and indoor facilities. This takes effect from tomorrow, Thursday 5 November through to (and including) Tuesday 2 December 2020. Please can clubs and venues ensure all their members are aware of the restrictions that will be in place from tomorrow.

In the short term, this means the following have all been postponed for this same period, and further instructions will be provided by relevant organisers following further review and when more information is available:

- **National Junior Winter League**
- **Kent Seniors Championships**
- **Junior County Squad Training**
